PADI Rescue Diver

The PADI Rescue Diver course prepares you to deal with dive emergencies, minor and major, using a variety of techniques. Through knowledge development and rescue exercises, you learn what to look for and how to respond. During rescue scenarios, you put into practice your knowledge and skills. Topics include:

- Self rescue
- Recognizing and managing stress in other divers
- Emergency management and equipment
- Rescuing panicked divers
- Rescuing unresponsive divers

Learn to prevent and manage many problems in the water and become more confident in your skills as a diver, knowing that you can help others if needed. During the course, you learn to become a better buddy by practicing problem solving skills until they become second nature. Plus, the course is just fun – it's serious, but still allows for lots of laughter in between the focused learning.

Course Prerequisites:

Minimum age: 12 (Age 12-14 may earn a Jr. Rescue Diver certification with Underwater Navigation training) PADI, SDI Advanced Open Water Diver certification or equivalent CPR and First Aid Dive Log book with no less than 20 logged dives in the last three years including salt water experience.

What each diver will need:

Each diver should have their basic scuba package. Some rentals are available. In addition, each student should have three cutting tools (one of which shears), one audible and at least one visual signaling device such as a surface marker buoy (recommended). Each student must have a CPR pocket mask, at least five pair of nitrile exam gloves and eye protection.
